

FAR FROM HOME, FAR FROM SAFE:

A TROUBLED INDUSTRY

Over 200,000 youth are currently held in poorly regulated facilities.

- 82% of programs use dangerous restraint practices
- 40% of programs use solitary confinement
- 145+ youth died from preventable causes including 65 from restraint asphyxiation or critical injury

- 43,000+ placed by Foster Care
- 44,000+ placed by Juvenile Justice
- 18,000+ placed by Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services
- 14,000+ placed by Department of Education
- Thousands placed by parent choice

\$52 Billion in Public Funds




BEHAVIOR MODIFICATION

Red Flags of when "Tough Love" is too tough.

- Admittance without consent or due process/ Involuntary and forceful escorting to program
- Aversive Behavior Modification/ Cruel and unusual punishments
- Prone Restraint used as punishment for "non-compliance"/ Stress Positions/ Infliction of painful punishments.
- Solitary Confinement / Long periods of forced silence
- Food/ Water/ Bathroom/ Sleep deprivation.
- Denial of communication with Parents/
 Access to law enforcement, lawyers and advocates to report abuse.

- Mail censorship.
- Denial of adequate medical care/
 Claiming students are "faking it"
- Placing higher level students in a position to police and punish lower level students.
- "Attack Therapy" Using mental, emotional and verbal abuse as "Treatment"
- Sexual abuse/ Forced sexualized behavior/ Sexual shaming
- Conversion Therapy/ Discrimination against LGBT Youth
- Forced Labor/ excessive exercise as punishment.
 (ie: 8 Hour Detention/ Digging holes/ Pulling a horse cart)
- Operating as a private/ unlicensed/ unregulated "Treatment Center" without being subject to regulation of clinical standards in patient care.

ENACT MEASURABLE CHANGE

1. FEDERAL LEGISLATION (2021)

This law will define institutional child abuse and neglect in congregate care settings and will provide funds for states to create protection and advocacy agencies, establish specific protections for youth, build infrastructure for proper reporting, and training for frontline staff.

2. STATE BY STATE REFORM

Enact laws to standardize the quality of care and oversight of youth in congregate care facilities in every state across the nation.


